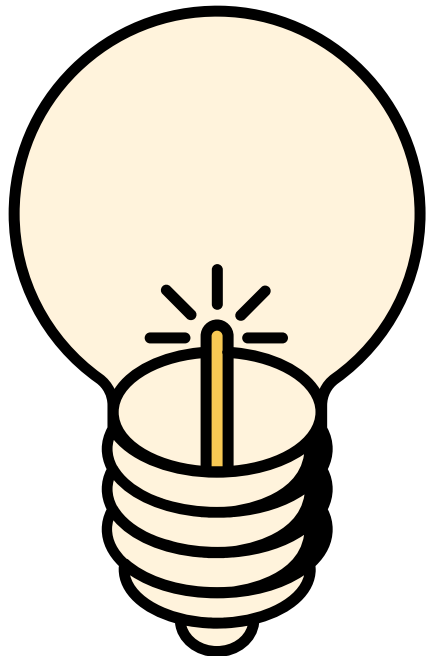


Goals

Senior Project

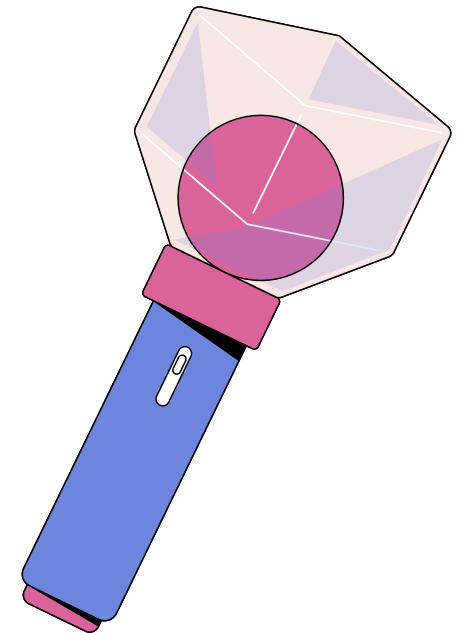
